

**An Amendment  
Presented by Thomas Willis  
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**Purpose:** To amend the SCSL Constitution so as to allow for marginally larger delegations

**Whereas,** Currently small schools of 1000 or less undergraduate students are capped at 8 delegates and Schools of larger populations have delegations capped at around 21 delegates (USC); and,

**Whereas,** If this program is to grow, our delegations must be able to grow in stride and this would allow for all delegations to grow an equal amount; and,

**Whereas,** This would also encourage more small delegations to join as they would be able to gain more support from their schools; and,

**Therefore,** Be it enacted by the South Carolina Student Legislature in regular session assembled the following:

**Section I:** To amend Article VI Section 3 (C) to read as follows

(C) Each member school shall be represented by a delegation consisting of:

1. A Chair;
2. Up to ~~two ten~~ six delegates per school;
3. One delegate for each 200 full time undergraduate students for the first 1,000 students (five possible);
4. One delegate for each 1,000 full time undergraduate students from 1,000 to 10,000 (nine possible); and
5. One delegate for each 3,000 full time undergraduate students from 10,000 up.
6. All numbers shall be rounded up if the numbers exceed the previous population bracket by more than fifty percent.

**Section II:** This amendment will go into effect after passage by the constitutional committee.
